Garrison Diversion Board of Directors Elects Three Members to Serve on Executive Committee

CARRINGTON (January 28, 2010) – The Garrison Diversion Conservancy District (Garrison Diversion) Board of Directors recently elected three members to serve on its Executive Committee. Elected were Jim Burbidge, Renville County Director; Dr. Bill Krivarchka, Traill County Director; and Thomas Olson, Stutsman County Director.

Jim Burbidge, representing Renville County, has been a director since 1999. He previously served one year on the Executive Committee. In addition, Jim will serve as Chairman of the Missouri River Committee. “I thank my fellow board members for electing me to the Executive Committee. I am happy for the opportunity to serve an additional term,” said Burbidge.

Newly elected to the Executive Committee is Dr. Bill Krivarchka, Traill County Director. The Executive Committee monitors the financials, federal matters and overall operations of the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District. The committee consists of ten members, each serving a two-year term, and is headed by the Chairman of the board, John Leininger, Griggs County Director.

The Garrison Diversion Board of Directors has 28 members, each of whom represents a member county. The board works to fulfill Garrison Diversion’s mission to provide a reliable, high quality and affordable water supply to benefit the people of North Dakota.
