A meeting of the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District Municipal, Rural & Industrial (MR&I) Committee was held on August 24, 2023. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Kaiser at 10 a.m.

The meeting was recorded to assist with compilation of the minutes.

READING OF THE MINUTES

Motion by Director Rogers to dispense with the reading and approve the May 10, 2023, MR&I Committee minutes. Second by Director Kassian. Upon voice vote, motion carried.

RETURN OF GRANT FUNDS

Chairperson Kaiser referred to the letter submitted to Tri-County Rural Water District regarding grant funds awarded from the Water Supply Assistance Grant Program (WSAGP) in the amount of \$10,000 for Marlin Reinhart. The project has not been completed, and the funds will be returned to the WSAGP account. He may reapply at a later date if he so desires.

CURRENT FUNDING TABLE & PROJECT REVIEW

Merri Mooridian, Secretary, reviewed the list of outstanding WSAGP projects through July 31, 2023, which total \$131,242. Approximately \$65,000 has been expended on projects in 2023. A copy of the list is attached to these minutes as Annex II.

COMPLETED PROJECTS

Ms. Mooridian reviewed the list of completed WSAGP projects. Projects approved through 2022 total \$192,029. Total expenditures on completed projects and current projects to date are around \$203,000. Total grant funds returned are \$56,009. A copy of the list is attached to these minutes as Annex III.

REVIEW OF GRANT APPLICATION

A copy of the WSAGP application form is provided with the meeting materials for the committee's referral.

REVIEW OF WATER SUPPLY ASSISTANCE GRANT APPLICATIONS

Rural Water Requests

Barnes Rural Water District

Blake Finger is requesting \$10,000 through Barnes Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line to his property in Barnes County for livestock. The total estimated project cost is \$22,050. The project is eligible for \$9,775 in grant funding. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex IV.

Matt Peterson is requesting \$10,000 through Barnes Rural Water District for a rural water hookup to his business operation near Courtenay located in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$33,400. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex V.

Wyatt Smith is requesting \$4,000 through Barnes Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence in Ransom County. The total estimated project cost is \$10,500. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VI.

Cass Rural Water District

Dylan Claus is requesting \$9,025 through Cass Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line to his residence in Cass County. The total estimated project cost is \$20,550. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VII.

Jack Korthof is requesting \$8,412.50 through Cass Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence in Cass County. The total estimated project cost is \$19,325. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VIII.

Central Plains Water District

Scott Foss is requesting \$10,000 through Central Plains Water District to install rural water at his farmstead located in Benson County. Total estimated project cost is \$23,149.75. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex IX.

North Prairie Regional Water District

Hunter Andes is requesting \$10,000 through North Prairie Regional Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence near Ryder in McLean County. The total estimated project cost is \$19,426.06. Taking into account the applicant is responsible for the first \$2,500, the project is eligible for funding in the amount \$8,463. The A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex X.

Wade Clark is requesting \$10,000 through North Prairie Regional Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence in Ward County. The total estimated project cost is \$67,500. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XI.

Southeast Water Users District

Deb Johanneson is requesting \$10,000 through Southeast Water Users District for a rural water hookup at her residence in Ransom County. The total estimated project cost is \$40,085.76. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XII.

Anthony Schmidt is requesting \$6,286.25 through Southeast Water Users District for a rural water line at his residence in Sargent County. The total estimated project cost is \$15,072.50. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XIII.

Travers and Brittany Storhaug are requesting \$1,660 through Southeast Water Users District for a rural water hookup at their residence in Sargent County. From the cost estimates included with the grant application, it was determined the project costs eligible for grant funding are \$2,035, and the total estimated project cost is \$6,570. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XIV.

Stutsman Rural Water District

Cecelia Collins is requesting \$2,565 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at her residence near Eldridge located in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$7,630. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XV.

Richard Kamletz is requesting \$1,950 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence near Jamestown located in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$6,400. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XVI.

Linda Kienzle is requesting emergency assistance in the amount of \$2,250 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at her residence in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$7,000. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XVII.

Chairperson Kaiser pointed out due to the emergency situation, the water line has been installed. The well went down, and water service was needed immediately.

Cody Michel is requesting \$3,210 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at his new home southeast of Jamestown in Stutsman County. The total estimated

project cost is \$8,920. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XVIII.

Milo Trucking is requesting \$3,500 through Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line to its business north of Jamestown located in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$9,500. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XIX.

Jordan and Erica Zillmer are requesting \$1,965 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at their new home south of Cleveland in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$6,430. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XX.

All Seasons Water Users District

Tiffany Sten is requesting emergency assistance in the amount of \$10,000 through All Seasons Water Users District for hookup to an existing rural waterline at her residence located in Benson County. The total estimated project cost is \$48,000. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex XXI.

Chairperson Kaiser pointed out this was an emergency situation due to well failure, and the water line was installed in July.

Consideration of Funding

Motion by Director Rogers and second by Director Blanchfield to approve funding in the amount of \$113,438 for allocation to the following projects:

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$9,775 to Barnes Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line for livestock at the property of Blake Finger in Barnes County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to Barnes Rural Water District for a rural water hookup to a business owned by Matt Peterson located near Courtenay in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$4,000 to Barnes Rural Water District for installation of a water line at the Wyatt Smith residence located in Ransom County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$9,025 to Cass Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line to the Dylan Claus residence in Cass County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$8,413 to Cass Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at the Jack Korthof residence in Cass County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to Central Plains Water District for installation of a water line at the farmstead of Scott Foss located in Benson County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$8,463 to North Prairie Regional Water District for installation of a rural water line at the Hunter Andes residence in McLean County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to North Prairie Regional Water District for installation of a rural water line to the Wade Clark residence in Ward County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to Southeast Water Users District for installation of a rural water line to the residence of Deb Johanneson in Ransom County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$6,287 to Southeast Water Users District for installation of a rural water line to the Anthony Schmidt residence in Sargent County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$2,035 to Southeast Water Users District for installation of a rural water line to the residence of Travers and Brittany Storhaug in Sargent County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$2,565 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line at the Cecelia Collins residence near Eldridge in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$1,950 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line at the Richard Kamletz residence near Jamestown in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$2,250 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line at the residence of Linda Kienzle in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$3,210 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line at the residence of Cody Michel southeast of Jamestown in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$3,500 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line at Milo Trucking north of Jamestown in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$1,965 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line at the Jordan and Erica Zillmer residence south of Cleveland in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to All Seasons Water Users District for hook up to an existing rural water line at the Tiffany Sten residence in Benson County.

Upon roll call vote, the following directors voted aye: Blanchfield, Kaiser, Kassian, Krueger, Rogers and Walter. Those voting nay: none. Motion carried.

Municipal Requests

City of Argusville

Chairperson Kaiser referred to the City of Argusville's two applications, requesting funding for valve box, gasket and hydrant replacements in the amount of \$10,500. The total estimated project costs are \$21,000. Copies of the grant applications are attached to these minutes as Annex XXII.

It was the consensus of the committee these items are considered routine maintenance and do not qualify for funding assistance.

Motion by Director Kassian to deny funding for the City of Argusville. Second by Director Walter. Upon roll call vote, the following directors voted aye: Blanchfield, Kaiser, Kassian, Krueger, Rogers and Walter. Those voting nay: none. Motion carried.

FEDERAL MR&I PROGRAM

Construction Report - - Ms. Mooridian reviewed the 2023 MR&I expenditures as of July 31, which total \$12,591,771. Remaining approved federal MR&I funds are \$19,156,138. A copy of the report is attached to these minutes as Annex XXIII.

Chairperson Kaiser asked if the \$19 million is for this biennium.

Ms. Mooridian replied it is based on the fiscal year from the federal government. There may be some Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-2023 included in the \$19 million. There is \$33 million for FY2022 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) funding that is not listed; however, a waiver has not yet been received from the Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) in order to spend these funds on the Northwest Area Water Supply (NAWS) Project.

Ms. Mooridian reported the waivers for rural water are hitting a roadblock. Discussions are ongoing with Senator Hoeven's office and Garrison Diversion's Washington, DC, legal counsel to assist with this situation.

FY2023 3rd **Quarter Report - -** Ms. Mooridian referred to the FY2023 Third Quarter Report submitted to Reclamation. This report provides an update on the status and funding of the current MR&I projects receiving federal funds. It is provided for the committee's information. A copy of the report is attached to these minutes as Annex XXIV.

Remaining MR&I Cost Ceiling - - Duane DeKrey, General Manager, Garrison Diversion, reported in order to increase the federal MR&I cost ceiling, it will require reopening the Dakota Water Resources Act (DWRA). Garrison Diversion is working with the tribes, Reclamation,

and Natural Resources Trust, Department of Water Resources to prepare a package with Senator Hoeven's office.

Ms. Mooridian added there is approximately \$11 million remaining of the cost ceiling.

OTHER BUSINESS

Application Guidelines - - Ms. Mooridian brought up the current May and August deadlines for submitting WSAGP applications. There are cases where grant applicants may need to have a decision before the deadline or prior to waiting for a MR&I Committee meeting to take place. As it currently stands, projects are not eligible for reimbursement if the work is started before the deadline.

Ms. Mooridian asked if the applicant could be allowed to hook up prior to the deadline. The application would still be brought to the MR&I Committee for consideration. The applicant would take on the risk of possibly not receiving funding. The other option would be to tell the applicant no funding would be awarded for work completed before the May 1 or August 1 deadlines.

Following committee discussion, it was agreed there are situations that arise when time is of the essence, and waiting for the application deadline is not feasible. The committee decided an applicant could move forward with their project, at their own risk, and the application would be considered at the next MR&I Committee meeting.

Motion by Director Kassian to allow Water Supply Assistance Grant Program applicants to proceed with installation of rural water projects, at their own risk, prior to MR&I Committee funding approval. Second by Director Walter. Upon voice vote, motion carried.

Ms. Mooridian asked regarding municipal applications, if equipment is considered an asset where replacement should be planned for, and planning is not done and the equipment wears out, would this be considered routine maintenance and not eligible for funding.

It was the consensus of the committee, under this scenario, funding would not be approved because it would be considered routine maintenance.

State Funding - - Director Rogers reported he had brought up the possibility of the state developing its own rural water grant funding program and Andrea Travnicek, Director, Department of Water Resources, suggested he put together a plan and submit it to her. He is open to any ideas for putting a proposed plan together.

Director Walter suggested giving Ms. Travnicek a copy of the WSAGP requirements and let them use those as a guideline for developing their own program.

Mr. DeKrey commented the proposal could be taken to the state legislature for possible funding.

Motion by Director Rogers to adjourn the meeting. Second by Director Walter. Upon voice vote, motion carried.

This FY2023 third quarter report is for the State of North Dakota Municipal, Rural, and Industrial (MR&I) Water Supply Program. Enclosed are tables for the MR&I project funding and expenditures, and a project status summary.

Eastern North Dakota Alternate Water Supply – The Eastern North Dakota Alternate Water Supply (ENDAWS) project is installation of 32 miles of transmission line from the McClusky Canal to serve as an alternate water supply for the Red River Valley Water Supply Project to provide a supplemental water supply in the event of drought conditions. Estimated cost is \$5,160,000 for 30 percent design and land acquisition. The 75 percent funding of \$3,870,000 includes a 2021 grant of \$2,370,000 and a 2023 grant of \$1,500,000.

Northwest Area Water Supply – The Northwest Area Water Supply (NAWS) project is a main transmission water supply project to serve approximately 81,000 people through connections with 14 communities and three rural water systems in north central North Dakota.

The Biota Water Treatment Plant (Contract 7-2A/4-1A) has an overall estimated cost of \$64.1 million. The grant funding of \$62,812,673 includes a 2018 grant of \$4,917,164, a 2020 grant of \$10,995,000, a 2021 grant of \$18,781,827, a 2022 grant of \$20,418,682, and a 2023 grant of \$7,700,000.

The Minot Water Treatment Plant Phase II (Contract 7-1B) has an overall estimated cost of \$32 million. The grant funding is \$14,859,836.

The Snake Creek Intake Modifications (Contract 6-1A) was split up into two contracts: Contract 1 includes all work inside the existing Snake Creek facilities and Contract 2 includes the project components outside the existing facilities, including the discharge and intake pipelines as well as intake screens. Estimated cost is \$48.8 million.

Snake Creek Pumping Plant Discharge Pipeline Contract 2-1E has an estimated cost of \$6.9 million, will be funded with a 2022 grant of \$4.5 million, and future reports will be in Cooperative Agreement R23AC00093.

Bottineau Reservoir and Pump Station (Contract 4-1E/4-2B) is a 3.0-million-gallon reservoir and 1,400-gallon per minute pump station with an estimated cost of \$11.2 million. This contract will be funded with a 2022 grant of \$7.4 million and future reports will be in Cooperative Agreement R23AC00093.

Lansford Reservoir and Pump Station (Contract 4-3A/5-3A) is a 4.5-million-gallon reservoir and 2,500-gallon per minute pump station with an estimated cost of \$11.6 million.

South Prairie Reservoir and Hydraulic Control Structure (Contract 5-1A) is a 10.5-million-gallon reservoir with an estimated cost of \$15.7 million.

Southwest Pipeline Project – Construction is continuing for the Supplemental Raw Water Intake (Contract 1-2A) with an estimated cost of \$25.6 million and a 2015 grant is \$2 million.

Construction is complete on the upgrades for the Dodge Pump Station (Contract 4-1E) and Richardton Pump Station (Contract 4-2B) with a cost of \$6,497,201




